to be with someone.*



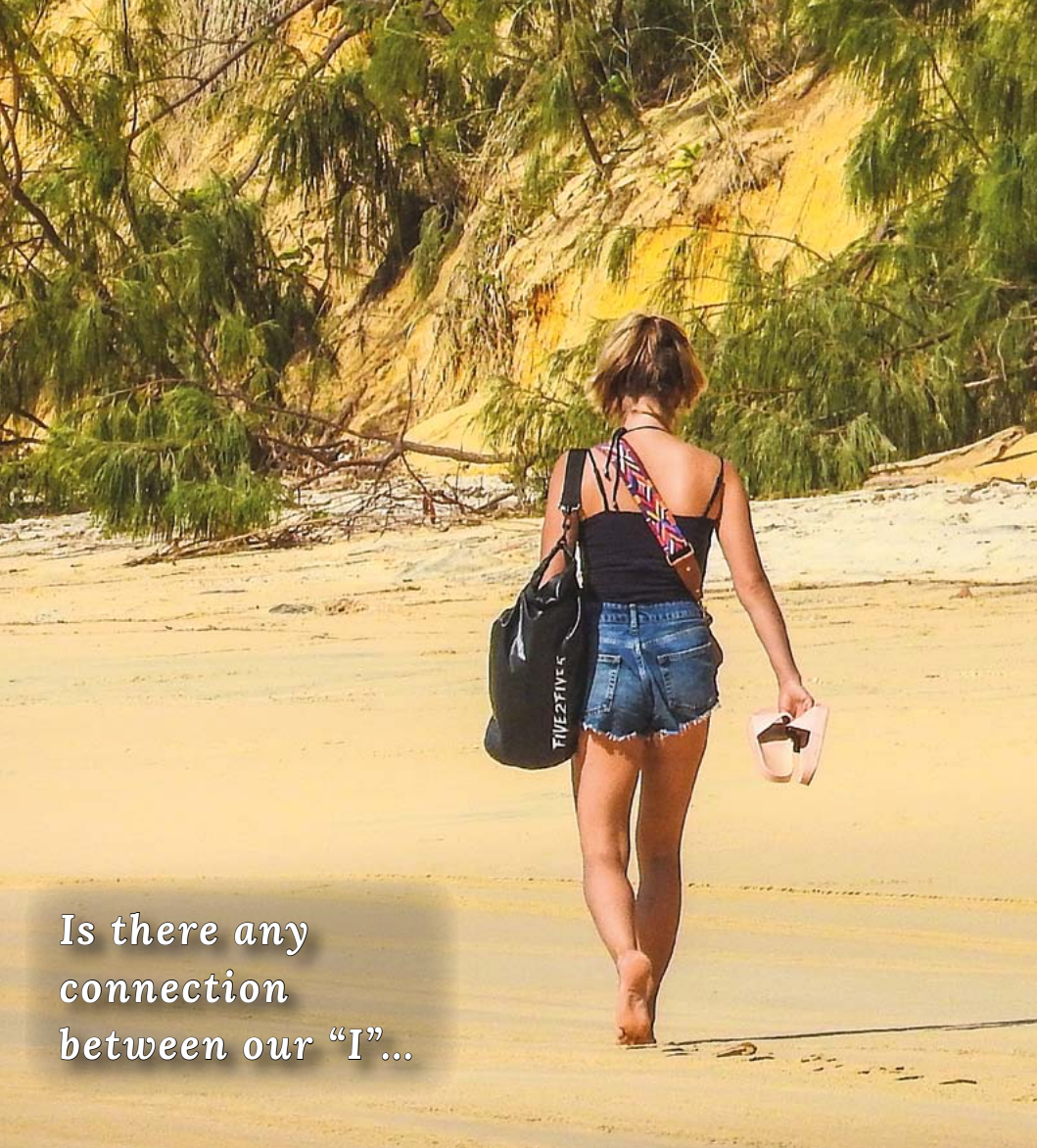
*Often, we also enjoy to feel like we

In general, people are quite “multilayer” creatures.



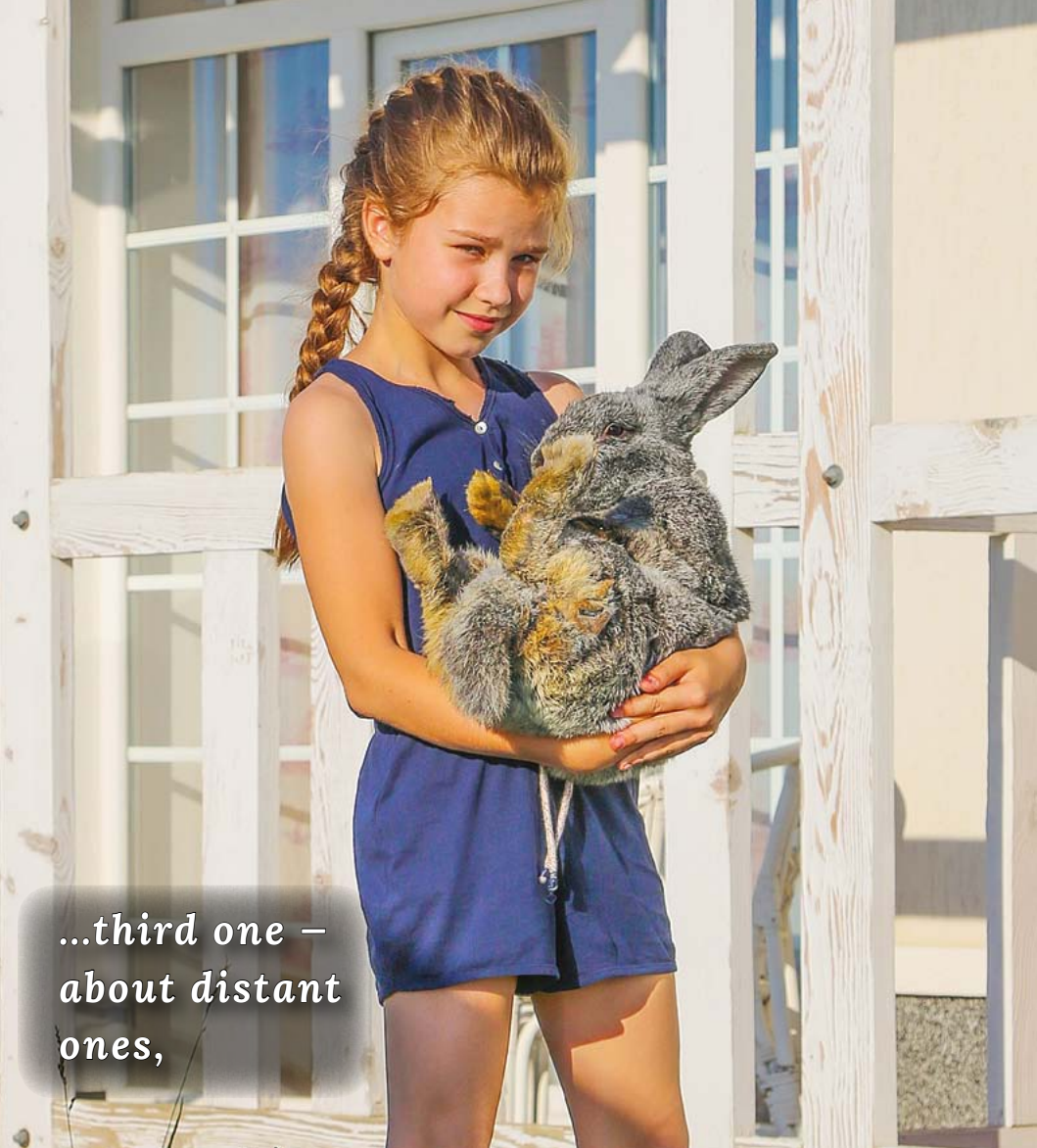
*And quite often these layers are

the differences in our characters.*



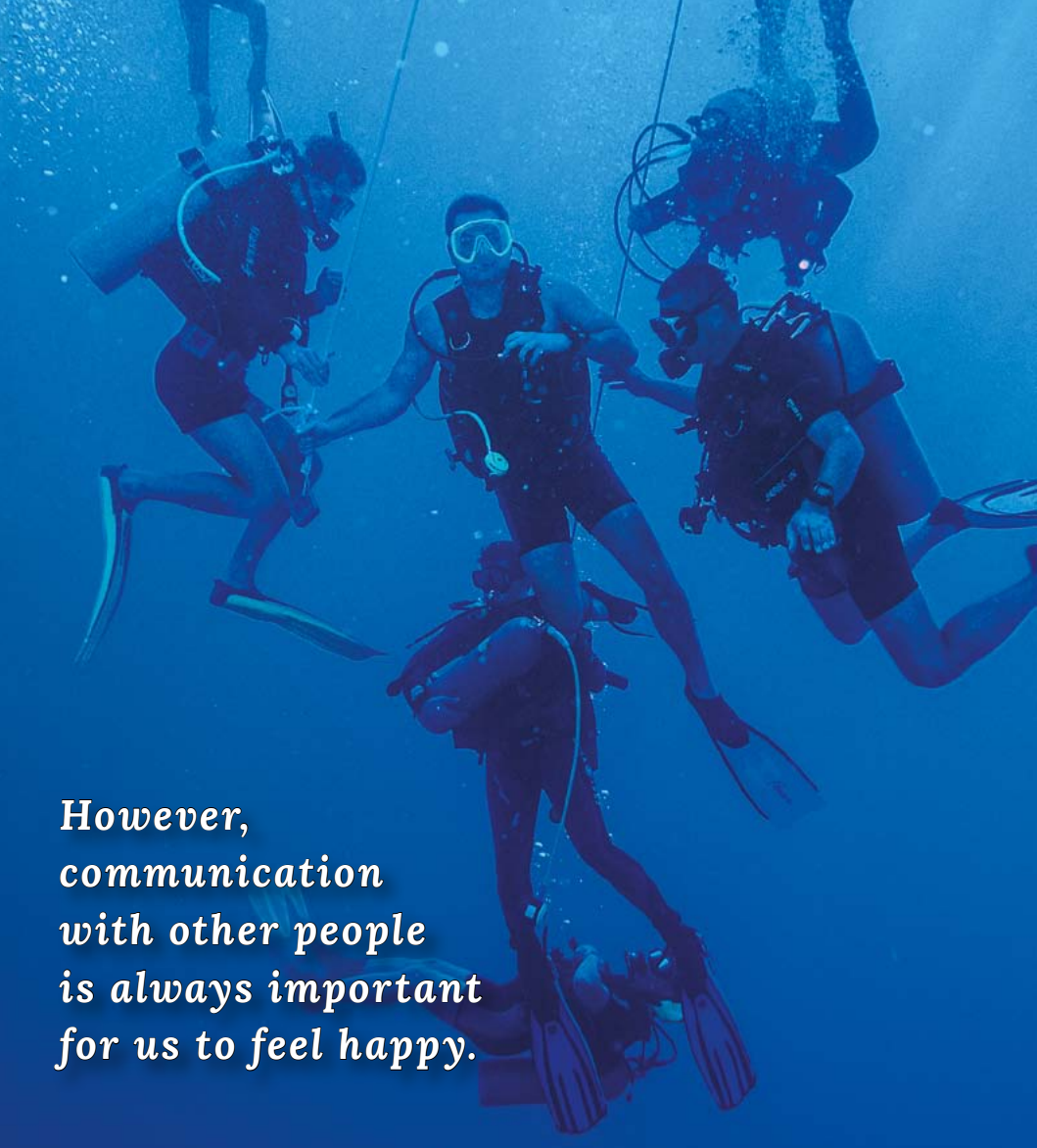
Our “I” is always limited only by the boundaries of our body (oh, ok, sometimes by the boundaries of our toys).



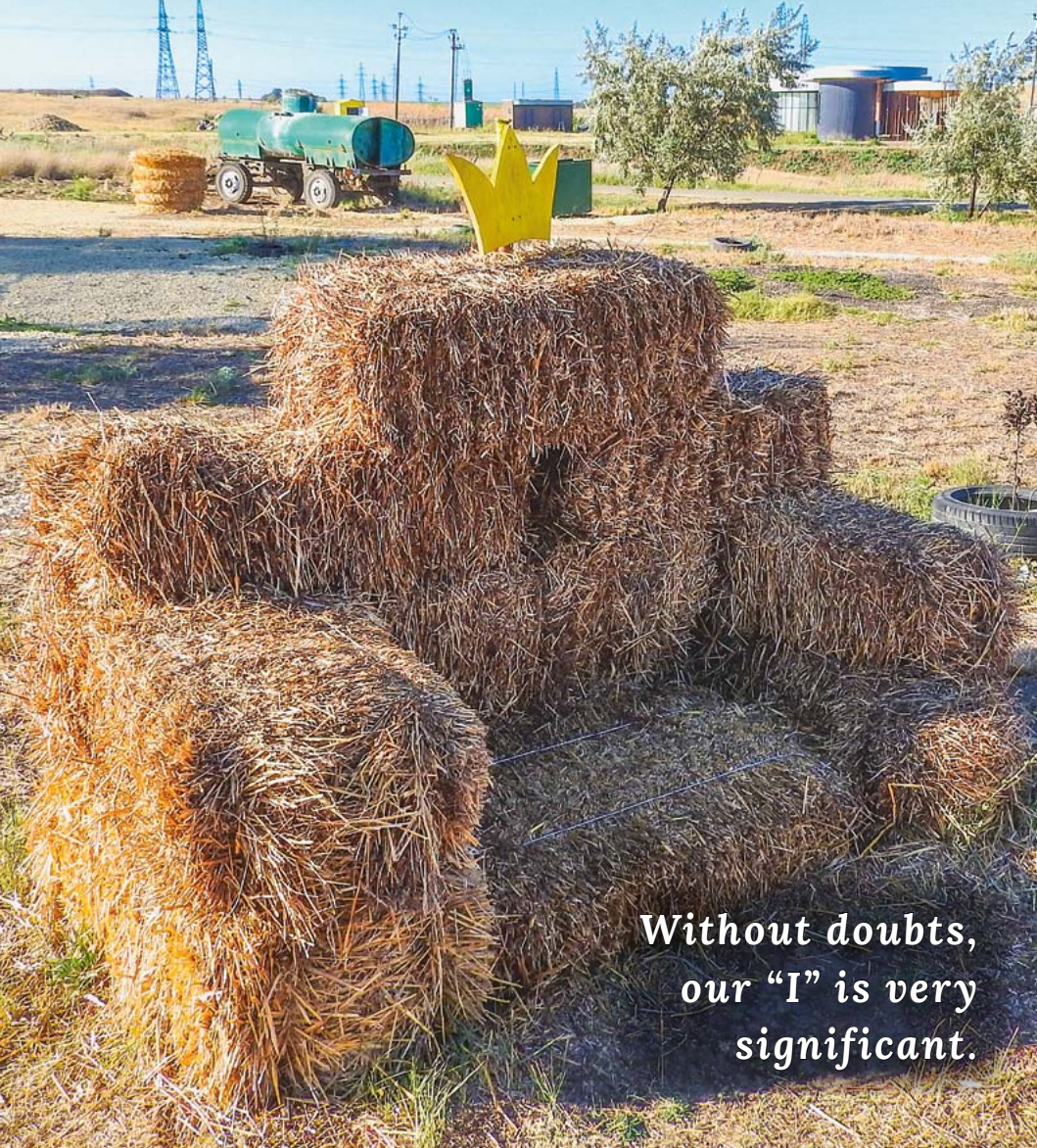
But our “we” can be much broader.

significant.*



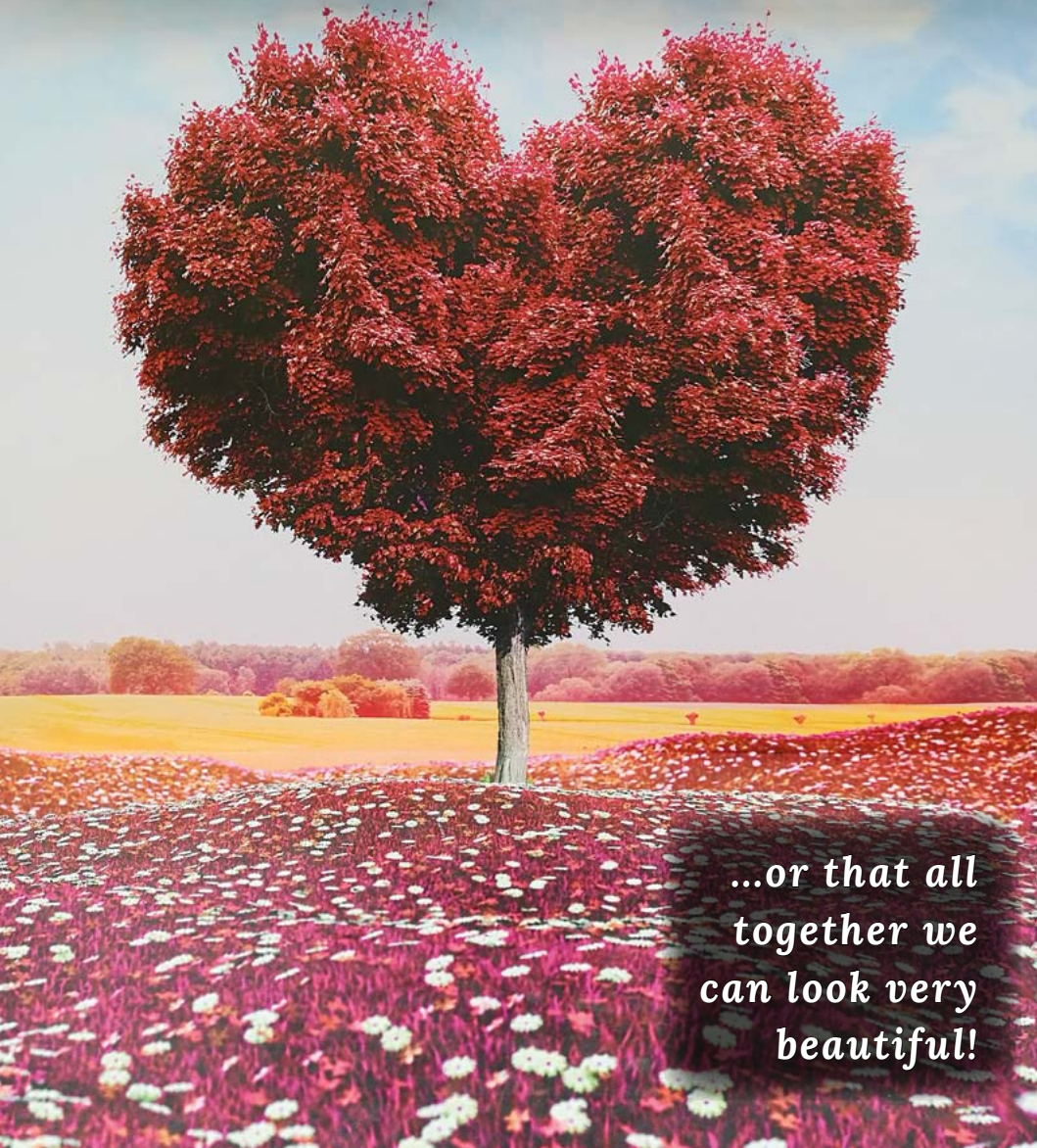
*Furthermore, only personality

a lot of similar “I”...*



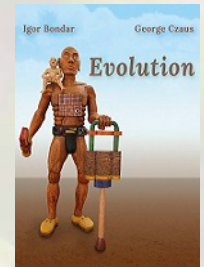
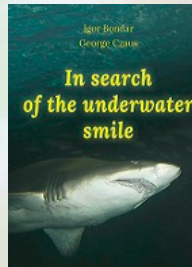
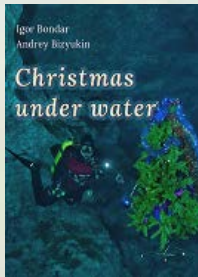
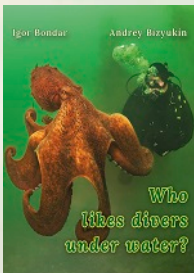
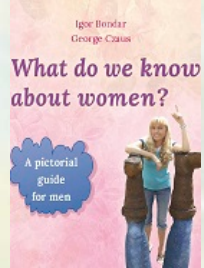
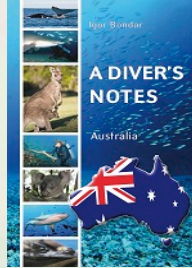
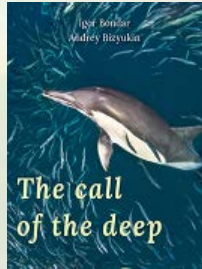
